LENT Associated customs and traditions

There are traditionally 40 days in Lent; these are marked by fasting, both from foods and festivities, and by other acts of **penance**. The three traditional practices to be taken up with renewed vigour during Lent are **prayer** (**justice** towards God), fasting (**justice** towards self), and **almsgiving** (**justice** towards neighbours); these are known as the three pillars of Lent.^[47]

Self-reflection, simplicity and sincerity (honesty) are emphasized during the Lenten season.^[1]

However, in modern times, observers additionally give up partaking in personal luxuries (e.g. watching television) and often invest the time or money saved in **charitable** purposes or organizations
