LENT Associated customs and traditions

There are traditionally 40 days in Lent; these are marked by fasting, both from foods and festivities, and by other acts of penance. The three traditional practices to be taken up with renewed vigour during Lent are prayer (justice towards God), fasting (justice towards self), and almsgiving (justice towards neighbours); these are known as the three pillars of Lent.^[47]

Self-reflection, simplicity and sincerity (honesty) are emphasized during the Lenten season.[1]

However, in modern times, observers additionally give up partaking in personal luxuries (e.g. watching television) and often invest the time or money saved in charitable purposes or organizations
